She has developed and led groundbreaking business models and partnerships with global multi-sector organizations including governments, corporates, United Nations agencies, and grassroots social entrepreneurs.

Brooke focuses her work on the intersection of global health, digital technology, and gender issues. She strongly believes in digital human rights and in an individual’s right to protect their personal information as they navigate health systems and receive care.
