



PRIVACY POLICY

1. Introduction

(a) Website Owner

85 Broads Unlimited LLC dba Ellevate Network (“Company”) is the owner of this website (“Company Website”). Company can be contacted by email at elle@ellevatenetwork.com or by mail at 265 Franklin Street, Ste 1702, Boston, MA 02110.

(b) Website Visits

Users should promptly notify Company if personal or payment information is lost or compromised.

(e) Forums and Public Areas

Information shared in chat rooms, forums, or public spaces may be visible to others. Users should exercise caution when sharing personal information.

(f) Links to Other Websites

The Company Website may contain links to third-party websites. Company is not responsible for the privacy practices or content of those sites.

3. Uses Made of the Information

(a) Operational Use

Company uses personal information to:

(b) Marketing Use

Company may use your information to share updates, services, and relevant opportunities unless you opt out.

(c) Stored Information

Information may be retained to improve user experience, recommend services, and support ongoing engagement with the platform.

Third-party providers may assist in delivering advertisements. Data used is typically aggregated and not personally identifiable. Users may opt out where applicable.

4. Disclosure of Information

(a) Within Organization

Information may be shared within Company and with trusted partners, including those outside the United States.

(b) Mergers and Acquisitions

In the event of a merger, sale, or acquisition involving Ellevate Network, personal information may be transferred as part of business assets.

(c) Service Providers

Company works with third parties (e.g., payment processors, hosting providers) who are contractually obligated to protect your information.

(d) Affiliated Businesses
