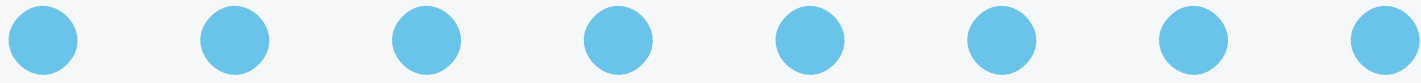


FFTA CALL FOR NOMINATIONS BOARD OF DIRECTORS
